



## 15 cards each 1 card swap Rules




2 – 8 players

(Medium level) Longer way to play

Choose a player to deal the cards. That person shuffles the whole pack and deals out 15 cards to each player face down.

Each player then takes the top 3 cards. Moving the remaining 12 to the right for later play, this will be called “Ready to play deck.” If the player wants, they can shuffle their own cards without viewing before the game begins.

The player to the left of the dealer starts the game by rolling the dice.

Looking at the 3 cards, identify the best one that matches the landed dice. First dice being , Blue, Red or Yellow, and the second dice being  for Highest or  for Lowest number.

For example:

 Red +  Highest

= card with Highest number Red.

Before laying your card down for the big reveal, players have to place all 3 cards face down. There’s an option to push a suggestion card to tease the opponent choosing. The player to left chooses a card from the player to the right to slide into their playing cards. Once all players have done this and

everyone have 3 cards. Without showing anyone, slide your selected card into the middle of the table face down. Wait until all players have done the same and say “Reveal!”

All players flip over their card to reveal who has the overall winning result.

If 2 or more players have matching numbers on that colour, roll the colour dice again to select another colour. This is done until there is 1 winner of that round.

The winner collects all played cards in that round and places them in the “Winning pile.”

All players will now have just 2 cards in their hands. Before the dice are thrown by the winner, all players need to pick up another card from their “Ready to play deck.”

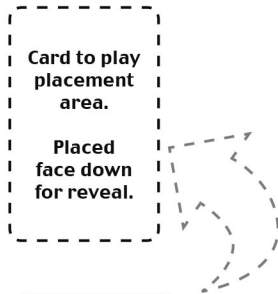
Repeat this process until there are no more cards in the Ready to play deck. The overall winner is the player with the most cards in their “Winning pile.”

If there’s a draw collect all the cards together, shuffle and each player in the draw picks a card off the top. Dice are thrown and the player with the best result is the overall winner of the game.

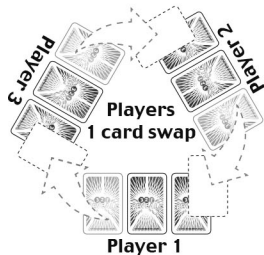
# 15 cards each 1 card swap Layout
